NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 35(1) OF THE NATIONAL WATER ACT, 1998 (ACT 36 OF 1998) TO APPLY FOR VERIFICATION OF THE LAWFULNESS OR EXTENT OF EXISTING TAKING AND STORING OF WATER

The Breede Olifants Catchment Management Agency (BGCMA), being the responsible authority, is undertaking the verification of all water uses in the Gouritz Water Management Area in terms of Section 35 of the National Water Act, 1998 ["the Act"].

The particulars of the property and the registration number of the water use registered in respect of the property set out below are as follows:

In view of the above, the responsible authority, herewith and in terms of Section 35(1) of the Act requires of you to apply for the verification of your water use in order to confirm the lawfulness or extent thereof.

To assist you with this application, an application form is attached hereto to be completed by you. You are not limited to only providing the information requested in the form and you may further motivate your application as you wish or as you may be advised to do. The application must be submitted to the responsible authority before or on **05 November 2024** at the above-mentioned address. The application may be mailed, faxed, emailed, or delivered by hand. If the time given to meet this request is insufficient, a written application for the extension of time (specific date) is required.

Please note that should the application not reach the responsible authority on or before the due date, or any approved extension of the due date, your entitlement to continue with your water use may lapse.

Please pay particular attention to Section 35(5)(a) of the Act, which states the following:

"No person who has been required to apply for verification under subsection (1) in respect of an existing lawful water use may exercise that water use –

(a) after the closing date specified in the notice, if that person has not applied for verification;"

Due to the implications of Section 35(5)(a) of the Act, it is in your best interest to comply with this notice.

Upon receipt of your application, the responsible authority may request further investigations in terms of Section 35(3) of the Act. You will be informed of this, if required. You then may make further representations before the delegated authority finally decides on your application in terms of Section 35(4) of the Act.

A final determination of your existing lawful water use is appealable to the Water Tribunal in terms of Section 148(1)(e) of the Act.

ANNEXURE 1

DESCRIPTION OF FOOT NOTES FROM TABLE 2:

- ^{*7} Field Area(ha) is the physical extent of the field area in hectare being irrigated, whilst Crop Area (ha) is used to indicate that more than one crop is irrigated on the same field in a year.
- ^{*2} In terms of regulation 3(b) of Regulations 1352 dated 12 November 1999 a person who uses water as contemplated in Section 21 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998) must, when called upon by the responsible authority to do so, register the water use. Notice Number 515, published in the Government Gazette Number 21215, dated 26 May 2000, requested the registration of water use in the Gouritz Water Management Area.

The registered water use is only a recording (by you) of the water uses and does not imply an existing lawful water use or an application for a water use entitlement.

*3 The proposed existing lawful uses are included in this application on pages 4 and 5 of this letter. You are required to indicate whether you agree with this determination. If you agree, your registration will be amended to reflect this. If you do not agree, proof of existing lawful use(s) must be provided (see point 3 of the Additional Notes) with this signed application.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

1. Irrigation requirements are calculated by means of a computer programme (SAPWAT) and calculations are based on specific climatic zones (rainfall and evaporation) and the irrigation system used. The use of this computer model is prescribed through the National Pricing Strategy. Please request in writing should you require more information regarding the crops and crop irrigation requirements for this property.

2. Existing Lawful Water Use

To qualify as Existing Lawful Water Use, a water use must meet the following criteria:

- a) The water must have been physically used in the two years before the commencement of the National Water Act, 1998 (the "Qualifying Period" [QP]).
 - 1 October 1996 to 30 September 1998 for groundwater, e.g. water from boreholes.
 - 1 October 1996 to 30 September 1998 for surface water, e.g. water from dams or rivers.

AND

b) The quantity of water used had to meet the requirements of any laws, such as the Water Act, 1956 (Act 54 of 1956), in force at that time.



- A water use may also be declared an existing lawful water use if it meets the requirements of Section 33 of the National Water Act, (Act 36 of 1998).

Validation and Verification of 21 (b) Water Use on Erf 385 Hoekwil

• Consolidation of 4 smaller into one single dam is confirmed to be a volume of 47 233 m³ (as per the attached survey completed by Atkinson Associates).



Figure 1: Satellite images showing location of 4 smaller dams which were consolidated into 1 single dam with a storage volume 47 233 m³

• In addition to this consolidated dam a smaller dam is located further to the east. This dam is visible in historical imagery from 1991 (Figure 1), 2000 (Figure 2) and 2013 (Figure 3).

- The estimated specifications of the dam during the qualifying period are as follows:
 - $\circ \quad \text{Estimated Surface Area: 2\,067}\ m^2$
 - o Estimated Wall Height: 5 m
 - Storage Volume¹: 4100 m³
- Based on this evidence the proposed existing lawful water use for Section 21 (b) is:
 - $\circ \quad 47\ 233\ m^{_3} + 4\ 100\ m^{_3} = 51\ 333\ m^{_3}$

¹ Assuming Volume = Surface Area x Wall Height x 0.4
